



TABLE SAW

COMPLETELY OFF LIMITS TO STUDENTS

**NEVER CUT FREEHAND WITH MOUNTED CIRCULAR SAWS
NEVER PLACE HANDS CLOSER THAN 6" TO A MOVING BLADE**

1. CONFIGURATION:

CIRCULAR BLADE MOUNTED INTO TABLE.

2. CUTTING ACTION:

**A. WOOD IS MOVED ACROSS TABLETOP EITHER AGAINST
FENCE OR PUSHED WITH MITER GAUGE: NEVER CUT FREEHAND**

3. ADJUSTMENTS:

A. BLADE CAN BE RAISED AND LOWERED

B. BLADE CAN BE TILTED TO THE RIGHT 0/45° FOR BEVEL CUTS

4. CUTS:

**A. STRAIGHT CUTS RIP CUTS (ALONG BOARD'S LENGTH) WITH
FENCE**

B. CROSS- CUTS ON PANELS WITH PANEL ATTACHMENT

**C. CROSS-CUTS AND MITER CUTS ON SHORT BOARDS WITH
MITER GAUGE**

D. DADO AND MILL WORK WITH FENCE

5. Safety: STRICTLY OFF LIMITS
