





Thickness Planer

<u>PERMISSION, TRAINING, AND</u> <u>SUPERVISION</u>

1.	Configuration: a series of 15 inch knives mounted on a
	horizontal spindle set above a short table and equipped with
	self-feeding rollers

- 2. Action:
 - a. Planer is used make the faces of a board flat and parallel
 - b. The wood is fed between the spinning roller/knife assembly and the table.

3. Adjustments:

- a. Table or blade elevation for thickness
- 4. Safety:
 - a. Must have had proper instructions on how to use the thickness planer.
 - b. Shop personnel must supervise you when using it.
 - c. Wood must be free of all dirt or any metal and paint.
 - d. Must wear face shields, dust mask, and ear protection when using the machine.
 - e. Remove only a maximum 1/16 of an inch at a time.
